**Subject: Policy of Not Accepting Any Kind of Gifts from Performing Duties
(No Gift Policy)**

Fiscal Year B.E. 2567 (2024)

According to the Cabinet Resolution on December 8th, 2020, the National Reform Plan on prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (Revised edition) aims to carry out Important Reform activities (Big Rock), Reform Activity 4, which focuses on developing Thai bureaucratic system to be transparent and without interests, has set Goal 1, item 1.1, this goal requires every government agency to declare themselves as an agency whose all government officials refrain from accepting any kind of gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy). This policy aims to establish an organizational culture built on values of integrity, morality, ethics, and transparency, in line with the principles of good governance. The objective is to prevent actions that may compromise discretion or decision-making during duty performance, thereby averting discrimination, conflicts of interest, and corruption.

Yala Rajabhat University would like to announce the intention of all administrators and personnel not to accept any kind of gifts from performing their duties (No Gift Policy). This announcement requires administrators and supervisors to serve as role models and to supervise subordinates, ensuring that they behave properly and adhere strictly to the following guidelines:

1. Do not seek to obtain gifts, presents, or any other unlawful benefits;
2. Do not offer or receive property or any other benefits as a result of performing duties, both before, during, and after performing duties. Such actions may lead to corruption and misconduct, both in the present and future;
3. Do not allow or connive with family members offering gifts or receiving gifts, or any other benefits to /from those whom related to the performing duties;
4. In cases where it is necessary to give or receive property or any other benefits based on ethical basis or customary practices, compliance must be maintained with the Regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Accepting Gifts by Government
